Transforming teaching and learning with Microsoft 365 for Education

St Peter's Church of England Aided School is a mixed secondary school for students aged 11 to 16, dedicated to preparing them for fulfilling lives. Recent inspections recognised the school's achievements, awarding an "Excellent" rating from SIAMS and a "Good" from Ofsted. Both highlighted the school's strong community spirit and commitment to high-quality education.

The Requirement

St Peter's Church of England Aided School needed help choosing the right Microsoft licensing options. The school found Microsoft's licensing structure complicated and wasn't sure which option would fit their needs best.
