The Requirement


The school needed to replace an entire IT suite with modern, reliable devices that were ready for Windows 11. Alongside this, they were asked to increase the number of available workstations in the room, all within a tight timeframe.

Our Solution

We supplied Aspect Nano ultra-compact PCs, which were easily mounted to the back of new monitors using the included VESA backplate. This gave the school flexible mounting options and a clean, all-inone style setup that not only sped up deployment but also maximised desk space, making room for more devices and giving students a better working environment.
